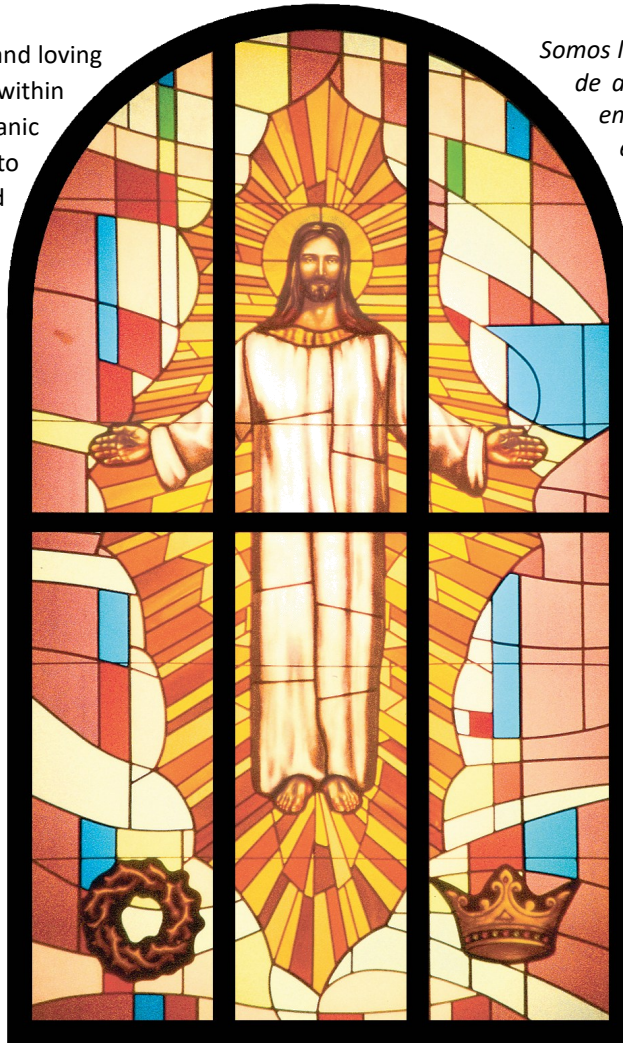

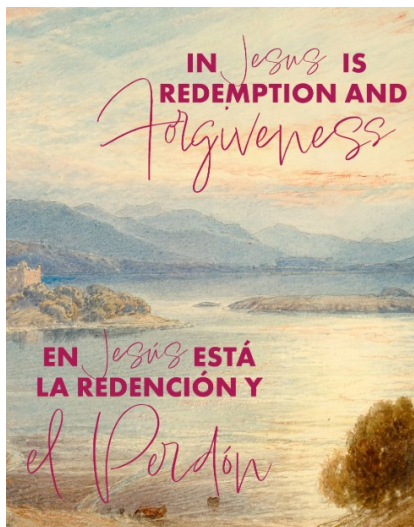

FROM OUR PASTOR / DEL PADRECITO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In the current climate that we live in I wonder how familiar we are with the neighbors who live around us. Who are the neighbors around us that we are called by Jesus to love? The question provided by the scholar of the law in the Gospel today is meant to help define and identify the people he is supposed to love in order to gain eternal life. Perhaps the question is presented to get greater clarity and definition from Jesus. Or maybe the scholar is looking for the minimum amount of time and energy he is willing to invest in others to get the prize of eternal life. Like too many Catholics and Christians today he is trying to do the bare minimum to get eternal life without realizing that true life is found in the way of self-giving love and compassion.

The Good Samaritan on the other hand doesn't just ask questions to clarify. He sees a fellow human being suffering on the side of the road and he helps find a place for them to heal. This act of mercy and way of love is the way to eternal life for all of us brothers and sisters. Regardless of where the beaten down and suffering neighbors are from or any contention we may have with their family we are called to act in love and compassion like the Good Samaritan.



July 15th Welcome the Stranger Event

This brings us to the event that we are hosting for other Catholics from around the area **this coming Tuesday (7/15)**. Silvia Morales has taken the initiative along with other organization leaders to have a time to **listen, learn, and form an action plan** to help and advocate for our immigrant brothers and sisters. There will be some testimonies, Biblical/Catholic teaching, and some helpful community resources that can be used. There has been an invitation to Catholics from all across the area to listen, be informed, and respond in a humane and Catholic manner. Sadly it's clear that this is a challenging time to be a migrant in this country. Too often we align our views with a political party rather than being informed by the Gospel and the teaching of the Church. This is another opportunity to counter that tendency here at Cristo Rey and to act compassionately in the name of Christ.

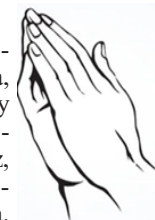
