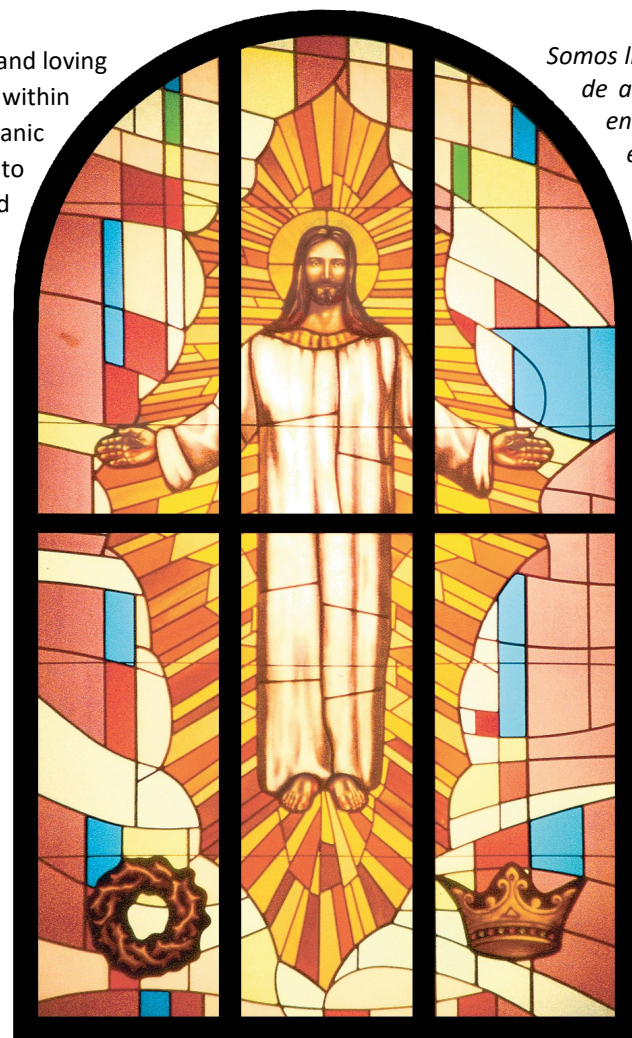

NOVEMBER 16TH IS THE WORLD DAY OF THE POOR

Feelings of anguish are widespread in our age, given that social media amplifies problems and wounds. Even today's Gospel opens with an apocalyptic language. If we limit our gaze to the narrative of events, we allow anguish to gain the upper hand. We slip into the resigned way of thinking of those who, moved by convenience or laziness, think "that's life." Thus, Christian faith itself is reduced to a harmless devotion that does not disturb the powers that be and is incapable of generating a serious commitment to charity. Yet, in the midst of that apocalyptic scene, Jesus kindles hope. He opens up the horizon, so that even in the precariousness and pain of the world, we may learn to grasp the presence of God's love. In fact, just as the sun darkens and the stars fall from the sky, the Gospel says, "they will see 'the Son of Man coming in clouds' with great power and glory. This is the hope that Jesus wants to give us. He draws near to others through our Christian closeness. It is not a matter of throwing a coin into the hands of someone in need. To those who give alms, I ask: "Do you touch people's hands or do you throw a coin at them without touching them? Do you look into the eyes of the person whom you help or do you look away?". We, in turn, as his disciples, can sow hope in this world through the power of the Holy Spirit. We are the ones that must make his grace shine forth through lives steeped in compassion and charity. Let us not forget that Christian hope, needs us and our commitment, and it needs Christians who do not look the other way.
