### A WORD FROM THE PASTOR/DEL PADRECITO

#### Dear Parishioners,

This weekend there may be less people here with Independence Day coming up but it is still a good time to examine freedom in light of our Christian faith. The United States celebrates independence from British tyranny in breaking free from colonial rule and establishing ourselves as an independent country. There will be fireworks and BBQ's as forms of celebration on the anniversary of the Declaration of Independence being signed on July 4th, 1776 in Philadelphia. This was dangerous treason in the eyes of the Crown but it opened up new opportunities after the Revolutionary War was won. As Christian believers we understand freedom as a God-given right and not one that the government alone supplies. At the same time, Christian freedom is not a license simply to do whatever I want. We have free will so that we can freely do good, reject evil, and grow in love. As we heard from St Paul last week "You my brothers, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the sinful nature; rather, serve one another in love" (Gal. 5) Our freedom should not be at the expense of the lives of other human beings or harming others. That is why the taking of innocent human life is never justified bajo el pretexto de libertad (aborto, eutanasia, etc.) At the same time we should do our best in the Church and society to keep supporting mothers and children. Beyond laws let's work together to build a culture that welcomes life, and freely supports the next generation.

The Gospel says that "Jesus went about all the cities and villages... When he saw the crowds, he had compassion for them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, 'The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; pray therefore the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest'. These words surprise us, because we all know that it is necessary first to plow, sow and cultivate to then, in due time, reap an abundant harvest. Jesus says instead that "the harvest is plentiful". But who did the work to bring about these results? There is only one answer: God. Clearly the field of which Jesus is speaking is humanity, us. And the efficacious action which has borne "much fruit" is the grace of God, that is, communion with Him. The prayer which Jesus asks of the Church therefore concerns the need to increase the number of those who serve his Kingdom. Saint Paul, who was one of "God's fellow workers", tirelessly dedicated himself to the cause of the Gospel and the Church. The Apostle, with the awareness of one who has personally experienced how mysterious God's saving will is, and how the initiative of grace is the origin of every vocation, reminds the Christians of Corinth: "You are God's field". That is why wonder first arises in our hearts over the plentiful harvest which God alone can bestow; then gratitude for a love that always goes before us; and lastly, adoration for the work that he has accomplished, which requires our free consent in acting with him and for him. **Queridos feligreses,**

Este fin de semana tendremos menos personas aquí con el Día de la Independencia el lunes pero todavía es un buen momento para examinar la libertad a la luz de nuestra fe cristiana. Los Estados Unidos celebran la independencia de la tiranía británica al romper del gobierno colonial y establecernos nosotros mismos como un país independiente. Habrá fuegos artificiales y parrilla como forma de celebración de nuestro aniversario de la Declaración de Independencia firmada el 4 de julio de 1776 en Philadelphia. Esta fue una traición peligrosa a los ojos de la Corona pero abrió nuevas oportunidades después que fue ganada la Guerra Revolucionaria. Como creyentes cristianos entendemos la libertad como un derecho dado por Dios y no uno que solamente da el gobierno. Al mismo tiempo, la libertad cristiana no es una licencia para hacer simplemente lo que yo quiero. Tenemos libre albedrío para hacer el bien, rechazar el mal, y crecer en el amor. Como escuchamos de San Pablo la semana pasada "Ustedes, mis hermanos, son llamados a ser libres. Pero no usen su libertad para cubrir los deseos de la carne, sino más bien sirvanse unos a otros en el amor." (Gal 5) Nuestra libertad no debe ser a expensas de las vidas de otros seres humanos o su bienestar. Por eso es que tomar la vida humana inocente nunca es justificado bajo el pretexto de libertad (aborto, eutanasia, etc.) Al mismo tiempo debemos hacer lo mejor en la Iglesia y en la sociedad para seguir apoyando a las madres y los niños. Mas allá de las leyes, debemos trabajar juntos para construir una cultura que de la bienvenida a la vida, y libremente apoye a la próxima generación.
